### PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- Current Enrollment: 796 Students
- Staffing
  - We want to welcome Dr. Sterling and Mr. Morris! Our brand-new assistant principals! We also want to thank Ms. Alicia Stephens for her hard work at HHS during the transition. She will be missed!
  - We are fully staffed for SY 23-24 except for two open teaching vacancies and an Administrative Officer.
    - We have hired our AO, but don't expect a start date prior to the end of the school year.
    - The vacant teaching positions are for a Math and a French/Biology teacher. We expect them to be vacant for the remainder of the year.
    - Long-term substitutes
      - Two long-term substitutes for open teaching vacancies (referenced above). We also have a long-term substitute in LTC Mateer's position.
    - Staffing for SY 24-25
      - We have hired five positions for next school year.
      - We have one vacant SPED teaching position to hire and two vacant SPED paraprofessional positions to hire.
- Master Schedule SY 24-25
  - Counselors have finished meeting with 8<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> grade students and will have finished inputting course requests before spring break.
  - SY 24-25 student schedules are on track for distribution near the end of May or the first week of June.
- Bell Schedule SY 24-25
  - The Garrison has approved HHS for open campus lunch next school year.
  - Included with this report is the proposed bell schedule and white paper. Highlights of the new bell schedule are:
    - One lunch (40 minutes)
    - Open Campus for Seniors and honor roll Juniors (Freshmen and Sophomores must stay on campus but are not confined to the cafeteria. There is a possibility of Sophomore honor roll students for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester)
    - 60 minutes of Academic Enrichment
    - Rotating schedule to allow teachers and students to see each other at different times throughout the day.
