PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- Current Enrollment: 780 Students
- Staffing
 - We currently have three long term substitutes.
 - One is for Ms. Gleason's PE position, one is for the French/Biology position, and one is for LTC Mateer's JROTC position.
 - Our new Administrative Officer has a starting date of June 16th.
 - Staffing for SY 24-25 is nearly complete.
 - We have hired for all current vacant teaching positions.
 - Nearly all new hires have already cleared security and have starting dates in August. We feel confident will be fully staff at the start of SY 24-25 (if we do not have unexpected resignations, retirements, etc. in the summer)
 - We have one vacant SPED paraprofessional position to hire.

 - SY 24-25 student schedules will be emailed on May 31st. Please note, these are TENTATIVE schedules.
 - Schedule changes will NOT be made until August. There will be a link to place requests throughout the summer.
