PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- Current Enrollment: 791 Students
- Staffing
 - We currently have four administration/educator vacancies. We have a vacant assistant principal position, a vacant health/biology position, a vacant engineering position, and a vacant Senior JROTC position.
 - We currently have three GS vacancies. We have a vacant office automation position, a vacant DVS clerk, and a vacant student transition coordinator aide.
 - We expect these positions to be vacant for the remainder of the year.
 - Long-terms substitutes
 - Three long-term substitutes for open teaching vacancies (referenced above). We also have a long-term substitute in Mr. Wright's and Ms. Kim's classrooms as they are on paternity leave and one long-term substitute for a paraprofessional position.

 - We have hired one position for next school year (Computer Science/ELA).
