## COMPETITION OVERVIEW

Whether applying individually or as a group, students will identify a problem or gap in the market, explain why it matters, and propose an innovative solution that could make a real impact.

Students can apply for one of five scholarship categories, each aligning with Immerse Education's world-class summer programmes in **leadership, business, STEM, and the humanities**.



### 1. Immerse Future Leaders & Creative Thinkers Scholarship

- For students passionate about leadership, business, law, or creative industries.

### 2. Immerse Future Engineers & Technology Pioneers Scholarship

1	<b>Identify a problem or gap in the market</b> - What issue are you tackling?
2	<b>Explain why it's important</b> - Why does this problem matter, and who does it affect?
3	<b>Propose an innovative solution</b> - What is your idea, and how does it work?
4	<b>Describe the impact</b> - What change will it create, and why is it valuable?
	<b>Bonus:</b> Entries that demonstrate teamwork, creativity, and originality will stand out!

## Awards & prizes

Each team member is expected to contribute equally, and all members of the same team will receive the same scholarship amount.	100%	1 winning submission will receive a 100% scholarship.
	75%	2 submissions will receive a 75% scholarship.
	50%	5 submissions will receive a 50% scholarship.
	10-30%	Runners-up will receive scholarships ranging from 10–30% based on judges' scores.

# Essential Details

- AP Tests are digital and hybrid this year. Bring your **charged ChromeBook and your ChromeBook charger** to every exam.
- Students need to memorize their CollegeBoard username and password.
- Students must report for morning testing at 7:45am and 11:45am for afternoon testing.
- If you are late to testing, you will not be able to join testing nor will you be eligible for late testing.
- Students and families must provide their own transportation to and from school on testing days. Morning testing will start before bus transportation arrives, and afternoon testing will end after the school day ends. **Plan accordingly.**
- Students testing in the morning will eat lunch after they conclude testing. Students testing in the afternoon will need to eat lunch at 11:15am.
- If you need a school lunch on any testing day, you need to **order a lunch** in advance. AP teachers have the order form.
- Students are recommended to pack lunch, water, and snacks.
- AP teachers will provide students with their testing location.
- Bring two pens with black or dark blue ink, calculators where needed.

4 function Calculator: AP Macroeconomics

### REGISTER EACH STUDENT WITH DODEA (NEW STUDENTS)

- » Obtain 10-digit DoDEA student ID# for all children from the school registrar.
- » You will need each student's ID# for step 3.

### REGISTER YOUR FAMILY ON LINQ CONNECT (OPTIONAL)

- » LINQ Connect is a secure, online system that allows parents/guardians to:
  - » Make Online payments for their student's meal accounts.
  - » Remotely monitor student accounts including the ability to set parental restrictions.
  - » Set up automatic recurring payments.
  - » Submit an online application for free or reduced meals.
- » If you have not already done so, you may register at [linqconnect.com](http://linqconnect.com).
- » Click on the verification link sent to the email address provided in the step above.
- » Now you can log in at [linqconnect.com](http://linqconnect.com) using your email and password.

### OPTIONS FOR DEPOSITING MONEY INTO YOUR STUDENT'S ACCOUNT

- » **Option 1:** Make deposits at your local Exchange Customer Service.
  - » There is no transaction fee for this service. You will need each student's DODEA ID# obtained in step 1 above.
- » **Option 2:** You may send cash to school with your student to be added through your school meal cashier. There is no transaction fee for this service.
- » **Option 3:** Add money to your student's account through LINQ Connect at [linqconnect.com](http://linqconnect.com)
  - » Any balance left in your student's account from the previous school year will carry over to the new school year.
  - » There is a \$2.60 bank convenience fee each time you add money through LINQ Connect. To save on processing fees, you may make one payment and then transfer funds from one student account to another, provided they are listed on the same family account.
  - » Click on Add Money to Meal Account and choose either One Time Account Payment or New Recurring Payment.

## **AAFES SCHOOL MEAL PROGRAM SCHOOL YEAR 2024/2025**

### **WHEN WILL I BE ABLE TO SEE MY STUDENT'S INFORMATION ON LINQ CONNECT?**

LINQ Connect is live for Meal Applications and setting up family accounts. Please note that over the summer students will not show as "enrolled" in the DODEA system until right before the school year begins, therefore you will not be able to link students that are new, changing schools or that have otherwise never been linked.

### **WHEN I LOG IN TO LINQ CONNECT, I DO NOT SEE MY CHILD'S ACCOUNT?**

If you haven't already done so, you will need to add your children to your LINQ Connect account. Click on the + sign then Link Student and complete information to link your child. You will need to complete this process for each child you wish to add. Please note: Over the summer, students may not show as "enrolled" in the DODEA system until right before the school year begins, therefore you will not be able to link students that are new, changing schools or that have otherwise never been linked.

### **WHAT IF I HAVE SEVERAL CHILDREN IN DIFFERENT SCHOOLS?**

You can add as many children as you need, provided they attend a school utilizing AAFES LINQ School Solutions for their cafeteria account.

### **CAN I SET UP RECURRING PAYMENTS?**

Yes. Click on +Add Money to Meal Account. Click on New Recurring Payment. Enter the Payment Amount for each child, Frequency of payments, Day of the week/month to charge the payments, Starting Date, Billing Address, Payment Method, Save.

### **HOW CAN I CANCEL OR CHANGE MY RECURRING PAYMENT?**
